

**PROCEEDINGS OF MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING
OF THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE, LOUISIANA
TUESDAY, APRIL 11, 2023– 5:00 P.M.**

The Town Council of Oak Grove met in regular session on Tuesday, April 11, 2023 at 5:00 p.m. in the council chambers at City Hall. Present for the meeting were Council Members Nevels, Walker, Allen and Phillips. Council Member Holland was absent. Mayor Rollinson presided.

Invocation was led by Council Member Nevels.

Council Member Nevels made a motion, seconded by Council Member Allen to approve the minutes of the March 14, 2023 meeting. The motion carried.

Council Member Allen made a motion, seconded by Council Member Phillips to approve the March 2023 financials and bills for payment. The motion carried.

Representatives from Northeast Delta Human Services Authority gave an overview of the many services that they provide.

Terry Lewis presented the rate study that he had prepared for water and sewer rates and answered questions from the council.

Council Member Nevels made a motion, seconded by Council Member Allen to adopt a Resolution naming April as Fair Housing Month. The motion carried.

Council Member Nevels made a motion, seconded by Council Member Phillips to adopt the annual MWPP Resolution. The motion carried.

The council received a quote from Red Hall for treatment of fire ants in the park and cemetery. The quote was \$450.00 for the park and \$450.00 for the cemetery. Council Member Allen made a motion, seconded by Council Member Phillips to accept the quote. The motion carried.

Mayor Rollinson stated he would like to appoint Jeff Moody as Town Superintendent to replace Karon Colquette who had recently retired. Mayor Rollinson stated that this appointment will leave the water/sewer department short one employee and therefore, he would like to advertise for an employee for that department. Council Member Walker made a motion, seconded by Council Member Allen to approve the Mayor's appointment of Jeff Moody as Town Superintendent and approved advertising for a water/sewer maintenance employee. The motion carried.

Superintendent Moody gave an update on the sewer treatment plant and ground storage tank.

With no further business to discuss at 5:25 p.m., Council Member Allen made a motion, seconded by Council Member Nevels to adjourn. The motion carried.
