

**PROCEEDINGS OF MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING
OF THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE, LOUISIANA
TUESDAY, AUGUST 8, 2023 – 5:00 P.M.**

The Town Council of Oak Grove met in regular session on August 8, 2023 at 5:00 p.m. Present for the meeting were Council Members Nevels, Walker, Allen, Holland and Phillips. Mayor Rollinson presided.

Invocation was led by Council Member Nevels.

Council Member Allen made a motion, seconded by Council Member Holland to approve the minutes of the July 11, 2023 council meeting. The motion carried.

Council Member Allen made a motion, seconded by Council Member Phillips to approve adding the following new business to the agenda: (A) discuss re-striping parking spaces; (B) Adopt a Resolution to amend the LGAP grant for a limb truck; (C) mosquito control in areas of standing water. The motion carried.

Council Member Allen made a motion, seconded by Council Member Phillips to approve the July 2023 bills for payment. The motion carried.

Council Member Allen made a motion, seconded by Council Member Nevels to approve advertising for bids for the installation of water meters. The motion carried.

Council Member Holland made a motion, seconded by Council Member Phillips to adopt a Resolution to allocate funds for an outdoor fitness court as part of the 2023 National Fitness Campaign. The motion carried.

Council Member Allen made a motion, seconded by Council Member Nevels to approve purchasing 16 spring banners for Main Street at a cost of \$843.00. The motion carried.

Council Member Holland made a motion, seconded by Council Member Phillips to approve Jason Hozak to attend water certification training in Ruston September 18th – 22nd. The motion carried.

Council Member Holland made a motion, seconded by Council Member Allen to approve Chief Russell to get quotes for re-striping parking spaces. The motion carried.

Council Member Allen made a motion, seconded by Council Member Holland to adopt a Resolution to amend the 21/22 LGAP grant to purchase a flatbed dump truck instead of a grapple truck to be used as a limb truck. The motion carried.

Council Member Walker stated that he was concerned about some of the ditches holding water and attracting mosquitoes that may carry West Nile Virus. Town Superintendent Moody stated that he would check on drainage issues as well as testing and treatment of mosquitoes in those ditches. No action was needed by the Council.

Council Member Allen made a motion, seconded by Council Member Holland to adjourn at 5:15 p.m. The motion carried.
