

**PROCEEDINGS OF MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING

The Town Council of Oak Grove met in regular session on Tuesday, November 14, 2023 at 5:00 p.m. in the council chambers of City Hall. Present for the meeting were Council Members Nevels, Walker, Allen, Holland, and Phillips. Mayor Rollinson presided.

The invocation was led by Council Member Nevels.

Council Member Holland made a motion, seconded by Council Member Allen to approve the minutes of the October 10, 2023 regular meeting and the November 1, 2023 special meeting. The motion carried.

Council Member Nevels made a motion, seconded by Council Member Allen to approve adding the following items as new business: (A) approve spending \$500 for food for the annual safety meeting. The motion carried.

Council Member Allen made a motion, seconded by Council Member Phillips, to approve the October 2023 financials and bills for payment. The motion carried.

Bids were received for painting the elevated water tank. The lowest bid was from Water Tank Services, LLC. In the amount of \$269,000.00. Council Member Allen made a motion, seconded by Council Member Holland, to accept this bid. The motion carried.

Council Member Holland made a motion, seconded by Council Member Phillips, to approve a \$500.00 contribution to the West Carroll Chamber of Commerce for the Christmas Festival. The motion carried.

Council Member Holland made a motion, seconded by Council Member Allen to approve hiring Otis Moore as a full-time water and sewer maintenance employee. The motion carried.

Council Member Allen made a motion, seconded by Council Member Holland, to approve purchasing six police barricades. The motion carried.

Council Member Nevels made a motion, seconded by Council Member Holland, to approve spending up to \$500.00 for food for the annual safety meeting. The motion carried.
