

**PROCEEDINGS OF MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING
OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF OAK GROVE, LOUISIANA
THURSDAY, OCTOBER 4, 2018 – 9:00 A.M.**

The Town Council of Oak Grove met in special session on Thursday, October 4, 2018 at 9:00 A.M. Present for the meeting were Council Members Nevels, Gammill, Walker and Rye. Council Member Allen was absent. Mayor Holland presided.

Invocation was led by Council Member Gammill.

Council Member Nevels made a motion, seconded by Council Member Gammill to adopt an Ordinance for flood damage prevention. The motion passed unanimously. The Ordinance is recorded in Ordinance book no. 3, page 162, as Ordinance No. 599.

Mayor Holland stated that the ground storage water tank has a very bad leak. He stated that he had spoken with Chris Patrick to see what needed to be done. He recommended having Water Tank Services clean and inspect the tank and make any repairs needed. Council Member Rye made a motion, seconded by Council Member Gammill to authorize the Mayor to have Water Tank Services clean and inspect the tank and to fix any problem up to \$5,000. Any amount over that would need to be brought back before the council. The motion passed unanimously.

With no further business to discuss at 9:05 A.M., Council Member Rye made a motion, seconded by Council Member Gammill to adjourn. The motion passed unanimously.
