

**PROCEEDINGS OF MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING  
OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF OAK GROVE, LOUISIANA  
TUESDAY, APRIL 14, 2026 – 5:00 P.M.**

The Town Council of Oak Grove met in regular session on Tuesday, April 14, 2026 at 5:00 p.m. in the council chambers at City Hall. Present for the meeting were Council Members Nevels, Allen and Holland and Attorney Lancaster. Council Members Hayes and Phillips were absent. Mayor Rollinson was absent, so Council Member Nevels presided as Mayor Pro Tem.

Invocation was led by Council Member Holland.

Council Member Holland made a motion, seconded by Council Member Allen to approve the minutes of the March 10, 2026 meeting. The motion carried.

Council Member Allen made a motion, seconded by Council Member Holland to approve the March financials and bills for payment. The motion carried.

Council Member Holland made a motion, seconded by Council Member Allen to introduce an Ordinance amending the Zoning Ordinance and set a public hearing for the May meeting. The motion carried. There will be a public hearing on Tuesday, May 12, 2026 at 5:00 p.m. to hear public comment of the proposed Ordinance. A copy of the proposed Ordinance is available in the Clerk's office at City Hall.

Council Member Holland made a motion, seconded by Council Member Allen to approve Kyle and LeAnne Harper's application for proposed changes to their property within the Historic District. The motion carried.

The Council reviewed a letter from the CBO concerning the property at 200 East Main Street. No action was needed.

Council Member Holland made a motion, seconded by Council Member Allen to have the property at 605 West Main Street inspected by the CBO to determine if it needs to be condemned. The motion carried.

Council Member Allen made a motion, seconded by Council Member Holland to approve the appointment of Trey Auger to the Zoning Board. The motion carried.

Council Member Holland made a motion, seconded by Council Member Allen to approve hiring James Mills as a full-time cemetery/maintenance employee. The motion carried.

Council Member Allen made a motion, seconded by Council Member Holland to adopt a Resolution to move the Grasshopper mower from the Cemetery fund to the Water fund. The motion carried.

Council Member Allen made a motion, seconded by Council Member Holland to approve a quote from Martin Communications in the amount of \$1,700.00 to install new electronic locks at the police front door. The motion carried.

Chief Holland gave his monthly report to the council.

At 5:08 p.m. Council Member Holland made a motion, seconded by Council Member Allen to enter into executive session to discuss possible litigation. The motion carried.

At 5:38 p.m. Council Member Allen made a motion, seconded by Council Member Holland to reenter into regular session. The motion carried.

Council Member Allen made a motion, seconded by Council Member Holland to have Attorney Lancaster respond to a letter from the attorney representing Justin George. The motion carried.
