

**PROCEEDINGS OF MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING  
OF THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE, LOUISIANA  
TUESDAY, MAY 18, 2021 – 4:30 P.M.  
CITY COUCIL CHAMBERS**

The Town Council of Oak Grove met in special session on Tuesday, May 18, 2021 at 4:30 p.m. Present for the meeting were Council Members Gammill, Walker, Allen and Rye. Council Member Nevels was absent. Mayor Holland presided.

Invocation was led by Council Member Allen.

Council Member Rye made a motion, seconded by Council Member Allen to adopt a preliminary Resolution declaring the intent to issue taxable sewer revenue bonds in the amount of \$300,000 to finance improvements to the sewer system. The motion carried.

Council Member Allen made a motion, seconded by Council Member Gammill to adopt a Resolution authorizing the Mayor to apply for a DRA grant for water system improvements. The motion passed unanimously.

Attorney Lancaster notified the council that the notice of intent to sell properties at 908 Gaston Street, 917 Gaston Street, 111 North Front Street and the old water plant at Railroad and Noble Street that were announced at the May 11, 2021 council meeting were done following the incorrect procedures. He explained that in order to sell these properties the council would need to first declare each property as surplus by Ordinance and set a minimum bid price. Attorney Lancaster stated that once the required legal advertisements and public hearings were done, the town could accept sealed bids and sell to the highest bidder. No action was required at the meeting.

Council Member Gammill made a motion, seconded by Council Member Rye to adopt the annual MWPP Resolution. The motion carried.

Council Member Allen made a motion, seconded by Council Member Gammill to approve transferring Sam Hodges from the water department to the street department. The motion carried.

Council Member Allen made a motion, seconded by Council Member Rye to approve Eddie Seaberry to work in the water department instead of the street department. The motion carried.

Council Member Allen made a motion, seconded by Council Member Gammill and unanimously approved to approve proclaim May 23 – 29, 2021 as Oak Grove Tiger Baseball Week in the Town of Oak Grove. The Proclamation is attached.
